Hello again, everyone!

The months are flying by and pretty soon we will be starting a new year, with hopefully a whole new board. September brings us some cooler weather, some craft shows may be starting up, and it's time to paint for fall, Halloween and Christmas.

In September we have Janet Mitchell coming from California to teach the Gnome Express. October will be Mary-Kate Erickson teaching the JOY sign from the very beginning to the end of a project. And in November we will have a silent auction of good pieces of wood, painting of our Chapter nametag pin for those who need to paint them, and a lesson on a bird painting provided by SDP and converted from oils to acrylics by Kaye Singer. More information will be forthcoming in next month's newsletter. And don't forget the Rosemary West Seminar September 24 and 25. The cost is \$100.00 and total is due by the end of August. All of these activities will require wearing a mask per current state regulations.

We did not have a quorum at the August meeting. We had a discussion about moving forward with the Chapter. SEPT. 11: "Gnome Express," designed by Julie Cloudand & taught by Janet Mitchell

The pattern for this design was given out free by SDP in 2019 to renewing members, so you may have it in your email or saved to your computer somewhere. If you need to purchase the pattern, you can obtain it



through the Decorative Painting store.

Janet will be give each student her instructions on how she teaches the design, which can be put on a 5" x 18" board, a can (both available at Michael's), round bucket, large terra cotta pot, an arrow sign from Cupboard Distributing, or even in your sketchbook.

The color Crisp Blue was left off the paint list. Substitutes could be Bright Blue or True Blue.

The fee for this workshop is \$20.00 If paying by Zelle, the fee is \$21.00

OCT. 9: "JOY" plaque designed by Shara Reiner & taught by Mary-Kate Erickson

This is a beginner piece and no prep work is required. Mary-Kate will teach us the proper



way to seal our raw wood, basecoat, transfer the design to the wood, paint it, and finish it.

The board is an 81/2" x 13" oval, but certainly can be put on something you have in your stash. You can enlarge or reduce the pattern to fit your surface. The pattern is in the December 2012 Paint Works magazine. Bring your paints and regular supplies.

NOV. 14: Silent Auction of Good Pieces of Wood, led by Marthalene Roberts.

Paint your Nametag, led by Jan Greene. Paints, pattern and pin will be provided, if needed.

Paint a bird pattern released by SDP, with Kaye Singer teaching the project on a small sled, plaque or plate.
