This is a beginner piece and no prep work is required.
Mary-Kate will teach us the proper way to seal our raw wood, basecoat, transfer the design to the wood, paint it, and finish it.



The board is an

81/2" x 13" oval, but certainly can be put on something you have in your stash. You can enlarge or reduce the pattern to fit your surface. The pattern is in the December 2012 Paint Works magazine. Bring your paints and regular supplies.
