I didn't take any classes until the 70's. I started with oils learning how to paint strawberries, lemons and chrysanthemums. However, my favorite medium now is acrylics.


I really enjoy Linda Sharp's designs but there are so many others that I enjoy. When I am not painting I like to garden, I also like to cut my own
