APRIL CLASS

As you may know, the April class will be taught by Kaye Singer. She is offering Oscar Ostrich by Marlene Kreutz CDA. During the February meeting Kaye was gracious enough to provide a photo and pattern for those who signed up that day.

The only prep required in advance of the class is to have your surface base coated. The suggested base coat is DecoArt Americana Natural Buff. An alternate is Delta's Fleshtone. The surface size is approximately 6"x6".

The paints you will need to bring (DecoArt Americana):

Avocado, Coral Blush, Titanium White, Leaf Green, Burnt Umber, Lamp Black, Warm White, Cad Yellow, Natural Buff, Zinc

Brushes: 4, 6 flats; #4 or #6 filbert, a ¾ or 1" wash brush, a good 10/0 liner and an old scruffy brush. NOTE: Bring a good, fairly large Mop Brush.

Tracing paper, graphite paper, and other normal painting supplies.

If you are coming to the April class, please send me your RSVP so we have sufficient patterns to distribute. Late sign-ups will receive their pattern packet the day of the class.

MAY CLASS

Sharon Shuster will teach Flower Market designed by Holly Hanley. It is your choice of surface – the original was a 14"x12"; however, Sharon enlarged hers 37% and she painted on solar screen.

The Palette:

DecoArt Cad Yellow, Ocean Blue, Laguna, Black, Milk Chocolate, Dragon Fruit, Sunny Day, White, Diox Purple, Spiced Pumpkin, Tuscan Red, Galaxy Glitter Ice Blue (optional)

Other: White Gelly Roll .05 pen

NOTE: Additional fee - There is a \$5.00 pattern. Cash or check goes to Sharon as she must purchase patterns from the original artist.
