APRIL 12 WORKSHOP

In April we have Kaye Singer teaching "Looking Glass House" on a glass block. Designed by Kaye. Fee is 20.00.

The pattern packet has drawings for both sides of the block and a hole to insert lights.

Block is $5 \frac{1}{2} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ or $3 \frac{1}{2} \times 7 \frac{1}{2}$. Kaye has 10 of the $3 \frac{1}{2} \times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ for sale for \$8.00 a block. She will prep for those who purchase one.

Hobby Lobby has 5 1/2 x 5 1/2, 4x4 and 4x3 1/2 blocks.

Medium used Acrylics and Glass paint.

Intermediate level.

Students should bring a small Lazy Susan or terry cloth to put the Glass Block on while painting.
