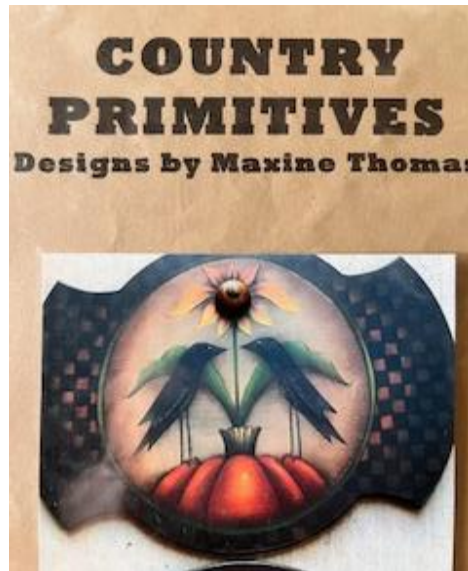
Fee: \$15 Two for One
